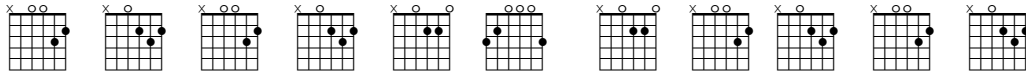


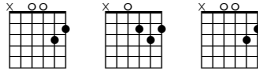
Lazy Man

Verse 1:



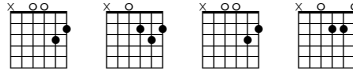
Well, it's six o'clock this morning,

And before he can say, 'It's time to start your day!'

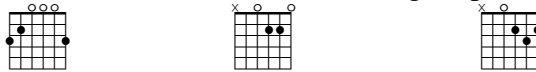


I hit the button and shut him off!
