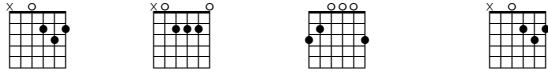
Verse 1:

Praying in earnest, through many a tear

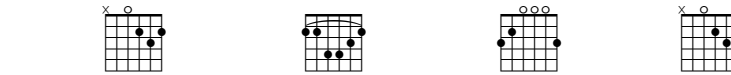


“If you are truly ‘The Lord God who sees me’,



Come and see the pain of Your servant here.”

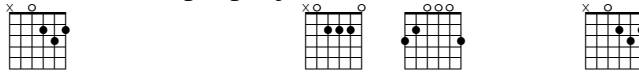
Chorus:



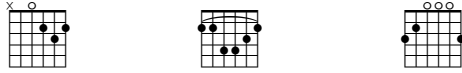
Come and See! Come and See what my master is doing



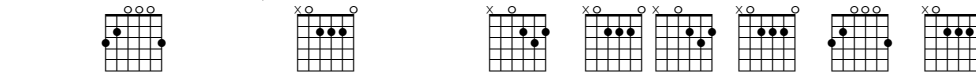
He lies to the people just to sell his own his wares
