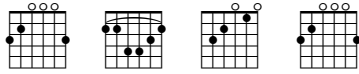


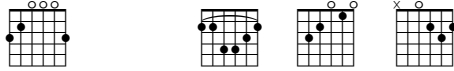

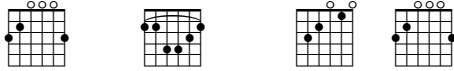
## Verse1:

The Word that's lived two thousand years

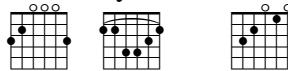


And the Love that it gives inside?

## Chorus:



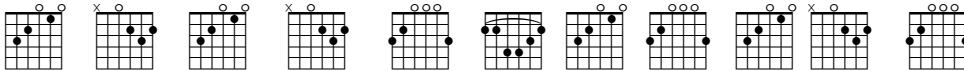
Was it Destiny that I should learn
